DISTRICT 1st PUBLIC HEARING MEETING MINUTES - October 9, 2017 – FINAL (KLVFD – Station #24 – 6:00 p.m.)

1. AGENDA

1.A. <u>Call to Order</u>

Chairman Allen called the District Meeting to order 6:00 p.m.

1.B. Pledge of Allegiance

Commissioner Cullen led the Pledge of Allegiance.

1.C. <u>Roll Call</u>

The Clerk called the roll. The following Commissioners were present: Tony Allen, Kay Cullen, George Mirabella, Danny Powers and Bob Thomas. There was a quorum.

Also present were Don Bock, Vicky Fay, Chris Jones, Matt Francis, David Garrido and Jennifer Johnson.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

2.A. Approval of October 9, 2017 Agenda

<u>MOTION</u>: Commissioner Powers made a motion *to approve the October 9, 2017 District Meeting Agenda,* which was seconded by CommissionerCullen. The Board unanimously passed the motion.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There was one request for Agenda Item 4.

4. DISCUSSION: KLFR&EMS Proposed District Budget FY 2017-2018

Sue Heim addressed the Board.

Jennifer Johnson presented the Proposed Budget. The tentative millage is 1.000 mill, which is 20.89% above the roll-back rate from the previous year's roll-back rate of.8272 mills. The committed fund balance includes the Trauma District funds of \$316,535 as of October 1, 2017. The unassigned projected fund balance as of September 30, 2018 is \$786,119. The committed Trauma District fund balance as of September 30, 2018 is projected at \$243,035 after expending approximately \$50,000 for KLVFD extrication equipment and \$24,000 for KLVAC for EMS reporting equipment; and the projected committed Vehicle Replacement fund balance as of September 30, 2018 is \$95,278.

There were no changes to the Proposed FY 2017-2018 Budget. During FY18 Legal and Finance will review the insurances for hurricane deductibles, and other possible policy changes.

The projected taxable value for the KLFR&EMS District is \$3,071,952,142.



5. MOTION/APPROVAL: Resolution #2017-005

The Clerk read Resolution #2017-005 into the record.

MOTION: Commissioner Cullen made a motion **to approve Resolution #2017-005 to adopt a tentative operating millage rate for the District of 1.0000 mills, which is greater than the rolled-back rate of .8272 by 20.89%.** The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mirabella, and the vote was as follows:

Cullen (Y), Mirabella (Y), Powers (Y), Thomas (Y) and Allen (Y), and the motion was Unanimously approved.

6. MOTION/APPROVAL: Resolution #2017-006

The Clerk read Resolution #2017-006 into the record.

MOTION: Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve Resolution #2017-006 to adopt a tentative budget of the District for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2017 and ending September 30, 2018 (the "Budget") in the amount Of \$4,605,055. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mirabella, and the vote was as follows:

Mirabella (Y), Powers (Y), Thomas (Y), Cullen (Y) and Allen (Y), and the motion was unanimous.

7. MOTION/APPROVAL: KLVFD Check Request Payroll \$50,693.72 (09/10/17-09/24/17) Johnson

MOTION: Commissioner Thomas made a motion **to approve the Check Request** In the amount of \$50,693.72 for payroll for the period of September 10, 2017 through September 24,2017. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Cullen, and the vote was as follows: Cullen (Y), Mirabella (N), Powers (Y), Thomas (Y), and Allen (Y), and the motion was approved.

8. ADJOURN

<u>MOTION:</u> Commissioner Thomas made a motion *to approve the Final Budget Hearing and the District Meeting dates on October 16, 2017.* Commissioner Cullen seconded the motion, and the Board unanimously passed the motion.
