RESOLUTION NO.2012-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE KEY LARGO FIRE RESCUE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO OPEN BURN ORDINANCE 2012-002.

WHEREAS, the Key Largo Fire Rescue and Emergency Medical Services District ("District") desires to protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the District has received comments from citizens concerning the Open Burn Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to protect the religious freedoms of all citizens; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to protect the freedom of American Indians to engage in ceremonial and traditional rites, including the open burning of ceremonial fires;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KEY LARGO FIRE RESCUE
AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Nothing in the Open Burn Ordinance (Ordinance 2012-002) is intended or shall be construed to disaffirm or contradict the American Indian Religious Freedom Act, 42 U.S.C.A. § 1996.

Section 2. Nothing in the Open Burn Ordinance (Ordinance 2012-002) is intended or shall be construed to disregard or infringe upon the inherent right of the American Indians to believe, express, and exercise the traditional religions of the American Indian, Eskimo, Aleut, and Native Hawaiians, including but not limited to access to sites, use and possession of sacred objects, and the freedom to engage in ceremonial and traditional rites including the open burning of ceremonial fires.

Section 3. Nothing in the Open Burn Ordinance (Ordinance 2012-002) is intended or Page 1 of 2

shall be construed to prevent citizens from burning ceremonial fires that do not present a threat to the public health, safety, and welfare.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
