Discussions were had regarding information received from Commissioner Mirabella's recent attendance at the 2022 FASD Conference, and new legislation on operational audits for special districts. J. Angle Group, LLC has worked with the Manatee County Fire Department and developed a bid process for the competitive procurement of auditors. Commissioner Mirabella further discussed the possibility of piggybacking on this bid at which time Legal suggested the formation of a Bid Committee consisting of members from the fire department, ambulance corps., and a couple of commissioners to explore the practicability of this process. Legal additionally suggested a Public Records Request be drafted to seek information regarding J. Angle Group, LLC's process in preparing a bid.

7b. DISCUSSION – Mirabella Presentation from 2022 Annual FASD Conference (MIRABELLA)

A slide show of information obtained by Commissioner Mirabella from the FASD conference was shown outlining SMART Objectives, i.e. District Performance Review, Special District Requirements and benefits of the program, the majority of which this Department is already utilizing.

Jennifer Johnson reported the total revenues were \$3,559,046.42 of 87.33% of the budget.

The District Expenses were at \$190,978.16 or 52.59% of the budget.

The Fire Department Expenses were at \$1,146,514.22 or 47.83% of the budget.

The Ambulance Corps Expenses were at \$512,057.44 or 32.96% of the budget.

The Total District Expenses were at \$1,849,549.93 or 42.87% of the budget.

10. AMBULANCE CORPS REPORT

10a. Monthly Reports (May 2022)

Scott Robinson discussed the Corps. responded to 815 calls over the past five months; 222 of which were North of MM103. One (1) volunteer was tested; 5 started over the past 30 days; 2 part-time medics were promoted to full-time, giving the Corps. a total of 6 full-time medics. The Corps. has two new rescue units.

11. FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

11a. Monthly Reports (May 2022)

Captain Garrido commented on 2 fires, which were total losses. However, they were able to save a puppy by administering oxygen. Commissioner Conklin commented on the passing of Dan Gleason and his commitment the department and community.

Discussions were had regarding new legislature and/or HB921 addressing restrictions to advertise to the Public. Commissioners Conklin and Mirabella have retained their seats unopposed going into the November 2022 election.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-003

A RESOLUTION OF THE KEY LARGO FIRE RESCUE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD, FLORIDA; DETERMINING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE, THE CURRENT YEAR ROLLED-BACK RATE, AND SETTING THE DATES, TIMES AND PLACES FOR THE FIRST AND SECOND BUDGET PUBLIC HEARINGS AS REQUIRED BY LAW; DIRECTING FINANCE TO FILE SAID RESOLUTION WITH THE **PROPERTY** APPRAISER OF **MONROE COUNTY** PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF FLORIDA STATUTES AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2022, the Honorable Scott P. Russell, Property Appraiser of Monroe County, Florida, served upon the Key Largo Fire Rescue and Emergency Medical Services District (the "District"), a "Certification of Taxable Value" certifying to the District its 2022 taxable value; and

WHEREAS, the District Board has reviewed the taxable value supplied by the Property Appraiser of Monroe County in accordance with Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, require that within thirty-five (35) days of service of the Certification of Taxable Value upon a special taxing district, said district shall be required to furnish to the Property Appraiser of Monroe County the proposed millage rate, the current year rolled-back rate, and the date, time and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage and the tentative budget; and

WHEREAS, the District Board desires to announce the dates of the first and second public hearings to the Property Appraiser of Monroe County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE KEY LARGO FIRE RESCUE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed millage is declared to be <u>1.0000</u> mills, which is <u>\$1.00</u> per \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the Key Largo Fire Rescue and Emergency Medical Services District, Florida. The proposed millage is <u>16.62%</u> greater than the rolled back rate.

Section 2. That the current year rolled-back millage rate, computed pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, is <u>.8575</u>, which is <u>\$.8575</u> per \$ 1,000.00 of assessed value.

Section 3. That the date, time and place of the first and second public hearings is set by the District Board as follows:
